ColliCare Logistics and PROJECT45 test the electric Scania in Poland

Gdynia, July 2024

ColliCare Logistics, in cooperation with PROJECT45, has completed the first joint tests of the Scania 40R electric truck for one of its clients. The test drives took place on an approximately 800-kilometer route between the center of the country and the port of Gdynia. This is the longest distance over which PROJECT45 tests an electric truck as part of the #WE ARE ELECTRIC project.



ColliCare Logistics has extensive experience in using electric vehicles, especially in Norway and Sweden, however these were their first tests of this type in Poland. PROJECT45 is developing a project called #WE ARE ELECTRIC, which assumes the electrification of fixed, regular routes and supply chains. Especially those that are based on the dropping of trailers, the so-called pooling. This allows for the appropriate optimization of the entire transport process and the use of electric cars.

During the tests, it was checked how the electric truck behaves in various road and weather conditions. An important aspect was to measure energy consumption depending on the weight of the transported goods.

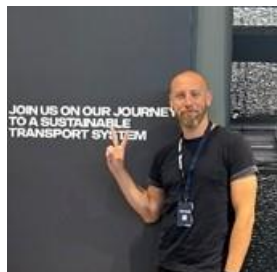
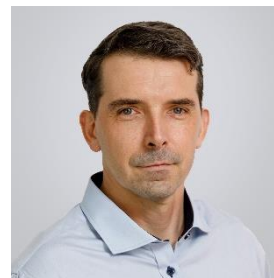
“The first results are very promising. The average energy consumption on the tested routes was around 1kWh/km. The key factor influencing the amount of energy consumption will be appropriate education and training of drivers. An electric car drives differently than a classic car with a combustion engine.” - says the representative of PROJECT45.

The load was finally delivered by sea to ColliCare's customer in Norway. The combination of road transport by electric truck and sea freight, offered by ColliCare, has allowed pollutant emissions to be reduced to an absolute minimum on this route.

The tests have shown that with proper planning of the route and charging points, it is already possible to implement electrified road transport over long distances in Poland. Both companies want to show that electric trucks on our roads are not a distant future, but a solution available now.

„We are happy about this cooperation and joint tests. As ColliCare, we strive to reduce pollutant emissions in transport. For years, we have been developing greener short-sea and rail transport solutions. As a ColliCare Group, we are also investing in electric road transport, but mainly in Scandinavia. These types of tests on Polish roads are very valuable experience for us.”

The tests carried out allow to believe that electric road transport in Poland is available today. This type of solutions can be effectively implemented, bringing benefits to both the environment and customers. New technologies enable the reduction of CO₂ emissions, and the joint activities of ColliCare and PROJECT45 are a step towards more sustainable logistics.
